Designer Finder Agreement

WEB PAGE DESIGN AGREEMENT

This agreement is made this ___ day of ___, 2___, by and between Publications and Communications, LP ("PCI"), a Texas Limited Partnership having its principal place of business at 11675 Jollyville Road, Suite 150, Austin, Texas 78759 and ___, a ___, having a place of business at ___ ("Member").

BACKGROUND

- a) PCI is a Texas Limited Partnership engaged in publishing various media.
- b) Currently, PCI has an agreement to design and publish a Web page to be displayed on the Internet for the Los Angeles Chapter of the American Society of Interior Designers ("ASID Chpater").
- c) It is intended that members of ASID/LA will be able to purchase an indiviual Web page to be displayed as part of the ASID/LA Chapter Web page.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. PCI agrees to design and publish for Member on the Internet a Member personal Web page ("Member Web page") as aprt of the ASID/LA Chapter Web page. The Member Web page will be in a standard format as shown on the brochure attached to this Agreement, but shall generally consist of a photograph of Member and text describing Member and Member's work.
2. Member agrees to compensate PCI for the design and publication of his/her Member Web page on the ASID/LA Chapter Web page in accordance with the rates completely described on Schedule B attached hereto.
3. Member agrees to abide by the tremns and conditions of design and advertising as completely described on Schedule B attached here.
4. This Agreement commences on the date first written above and shall terminate one year thereafter. Member may extend this Agreement for an addiotnal one year period by paying the Renewal Fee set forth on Schedule A.
5. Any notice required or desired to be given under this Agrrement shall be deemed given if in writing sent by certified mail to the principal office of PCI or to the residence of Member.
6. PCI's waiver of a breach of any provision of this Agreement by Member shall not operate or be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach by Member. No waiver shall be valid unless in writing and signed by an authorized officer of PCI.
7. Member agrees to defend, indemnify and hold PCI/ASID National/ASID LA Chapter harmless from any and all claims, actions and damamges arising out of the design and publication of any advertising by Member.
8. This Agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties. It may not be changed orally but only by an agreement in writing signed by the party against who enforcement of any waiver, change, modification, extension or discharge is sought.
9. This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas.

SCHEDULE A RATES

1. Member shall compensate PCI for design and publication of their Member Web page in accordance with the following:

Member shall pay PCI \$375 for the design, installation and display of Member Web page for one (1) year (the "Initial Fee"). This sum is due upon execution of this Agreement. Choose from the following options:

- Designer Search (3 pages, designer's photograph and 3 additional photographs); includes one category
- Additional pages can be purchased for \$100 per page (each additional page includes 3 photographs with descriptions)
- Link to additional Web site \$150
- Additional categories \$100 (includes one page)
- Each additional person profile \$150

RENEWING MEMBERS

2. Member may continue to have the Member Web page run on the ASID/LA Chapter Web page for the following year by paying a Renewal Fee equal to \$375, plus options. This amount is due and payable prior to the date of expiration of this Agreement.
3. Member agrees to pay all amounts due to PCI and mail payment to the ASID/LA Chapter office at 8087 Melrose Avenue, Ste B241, West Hollywood, California 90089. Credit card payments may be made to the ASID/LA Chapter office or to PCI, LP.
4. In the event ASID/LA Chapter does not receive the Renewal Fee by 5:00 p.m. on the first anniversary of the effective date of this Agreement, PCI will cancel and stop the publication of Member's Web page from the Internet.

SCHEDULE B PUBLICATION AND DESIGN TERMS

Design and publication of Member's Web page shall be in accordance with the following:

1. Member shall provide PCI a photograph of Member and the text to accompany the photograph which will describe Member and Member's work, areas of specialization and other information which Member desires to be included on Member's Web page consistent with the overall design of the Web site. The size, design, type style and all other elements of the Member Web page shall be in a standard format. See Interior Designer Finder brochure. Members are responsible for updating information, including but limited to, changes of address.
2. All subject matter, form, size, wording, illustrations, photography and typography are subject to PCI approval. PCI reserves the right to refuse to publish any copy or other material provided by Member.
3. All materials submitted by Member must comply with PCI standard specifications for Member's Web page. If they do not, and PCI provides additional services for camera shots, design, etc., Member agrees to compensate PCI for its services.
4. Member represents and warrants the he or she owns all right, title and interest in and to all materials submitted to PCI, that no third parties own any copyright or otherwise have any claims in and to the materials and Member is authorized to publish them and to grant PCI such rights as are required for PCI to publish Member's Web page. Member agrees to indemnify and hold PCI and ASID/LA Chapter harmless from any and all claims that arise against PCI and ASID/LA Chapter for the use and publication of any Member provided materials.
5. Member authorizes PCI to honor oral and electronically transmitted instructions (fax or e-mail) originating from Member or Member's agent as valid authorization for PCI to act. Written authorization can be on PCI's standard form or any other suitable form.
6. PCI will provide Member one printed copy of Member's Web page for Member's final approval before publication. Member will make such necessary alterations or corrections to Member's Web page and thereafter sign the copy indicating Member's approval of the copy and authorization for PCI to publish the material as indicated. Any alterations or changes to the photograph or copy after the original publication will be at an additional cost to Member.
7. PCI will reasonably house and maintain the ASID/LA Chapter Web page and Member's Web page to the best of its ability. However, PCI does not warrant Internet use or performance.
8. PCI is not liable for delays in accessibility of Member's Web page resulting from Internet use or performance, any act of God, action by any governmental agency, strikes or labor or dispute, shortage of materials, interruption of transportation or utility services or any other cause beyond its reasonable control.
9. Member agrees that if PCI is found liable to Member for any reason whatsoever, which liability arises out of this Agreement or publication of Member's Web page, that Member's damages are limited to the amount of the Initial Fee and any Renewal Fee, if any, paid by Member. PCI shall never be liable to Member for any amounts in excess of this amount.
10. Any controversy between the parties hereto involving the construction and application of any of the terms, covenants, or conditions of this Agreement shall be on the written request of one party served upon the other, be submitted to mediation, and if mediation is unsuccessful in resolving all of the disputes between the parties, than any and all remaining disputes shall be submitted to binding arbitration, and such arbitration shall comply with and be governed by the rules and regulations of the American Arbitration Association, except as said rules and regulations are modified by this Agreement, and in such event the provisions of this Agreement apply.
